### Please give your reasons:

Belfast is surrounded by dormitory towns in other councils such as Ballyclare, Carryduff, Moneyreagh, Bangor and Newtonards. This is why the 1971 - 2011 decline in population of Belfast occurred. None of these towns has sufficient employment, schools or hospitals to support their population, this results in the 100,000 journeys to Belfast mentioned in the draft and is illustrated daily in the Radio Ulster traffic broadcast.

If the draft plan is to be successful, then all the surrounding councils need to be in agreement to significantly reduce the future number of dwellings being built in their areas and improve facilities, employment etc within their towns for the current numbers. This is needed to reduce the transport demands to and from Belfast, the alternative will be road gridlock during peak travel times. It is not feasible to assume that people in the countryside or country towns can utilise public transport as it is not frequent or flexible enough.
